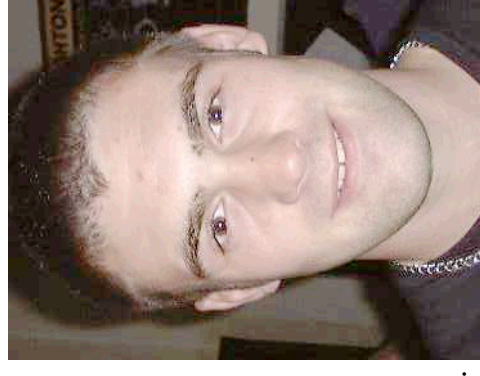

We hope that the referee has a good game and joins us afterwards together with Lymm players and supporters for hospitality and discussion of the finer points of Rugby.

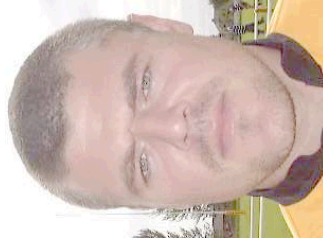

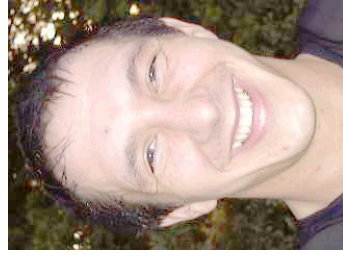
